Universal Travel has arranged discounts off the lowest fares that will save you money. Remember: on Friday, October 22, we will be in Canyonville, which is about two hours from the Eugene Airport, so scheduling a return flight for no earlier than 10:00 AM is advisable. If it is more convenient, we will be happy to take you back to the Eugene Hilton for an early Saturday departure.

We will make your reservation at the Eugene Hilton as well as the Seven Feathers Casino Resort. All participants will be staying at the same hotel this year in both cities! The Eugene Hilton runs a shuttle from the airport (about 9 miles away). We will arrange transportation for you from the Seven Feathers Casino Resort back to the airport in Eugene at the conclusion of the Seminar. **Note: it is important that we receive your flight information in order to reserve space for you on a bus that will get you there on time!**

The Eugene Hilton rate is \$119 per night and Seven Feathers Casino Resort is \$89 per night, plus any applicable taxes. (Note: Oregon has no sales tax.) If you want to see more of the area on your own, the hotel rates are guaranteed for both the weekend before and after the Seminar. Once again, **you are responsible for paying your own room charges plus incidentals, if any, to each hotel when you check out. One additional note: The Seven Feathers Casino Resort does not accept American Express.** Remember that hotel charges plus any other travel expenses including airfare, ground transportation, including taxi, airport shuttle, etc., and other meals, etc., are fully reimbursable under your capacity building grant agreement. You can make the reimbursement request to your program staff as soon as you incur these expenses.
