Research Intern

Local Initiatives Support Corporation (LISC), the nation's largest non-profit community development intermediary, seeks a graduate student summer intern (approximately 20 hours per week) in its Research and Assessment Department in Washington, DC. The 10-week internship will run approximately early-June to mid-August, however dates are flexible. A stipend is available.

The intern's primary responsibility will be to assemble and analyze data as part of a large neighborhood assessment project which will measure the organization's continued work in areas such as expanding capital investment in housing and other real estate, and increasing family income and wealth. The intern will collect and examine data from various federal agencies, including the US Census, Internal Revenue Service, United State Postal Service, Department of Commerce, Office of the Comptroller of the Currency, and Department of Education. The intern will also assist with other data and analysis projects as time permits.

Desired Skills:

- Interest in economic and social dynamics of neighborhoods;
- Ability to collect, organize and analyze data with SPSS or another statistical software package;
- Experience with GIS mapping software such as ArcGIS;
- Familiarity with using the web to acquire data from websites such as www.census.gov
- Ability to work independently
