

Multiple funding sources were used to develop affordable housing projects, including the following: City of Cincinnati capital, 9% Low-Income Housing Tax Credit (LIHTC), 4% Housing Tax Credits, the Affordable Housing Impact Investment Pool (launched by Greater Cincinnati Fund, administered by the Cincinnati Development Fund), HOME Program (administered by the City of Cincinnati, Hamilton County, and Ohio), FHAct50 (administered by OHFA), Housing Development Loan (administered by OHFA), City of Cincinnati Tax Increment Financing (TIF), Ohio Housing Trust Fund (administered by OHFA), and National Housing Trust Fund. \* OHFA = Ohio Housing Finance Agency
