| Organization | Headquarters | Healthy Housing Proposal Summary |
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| Adams Brown Community Action Partnership | Georgetown, OH | Rehabilitating homes to help low- and moderate-income (LMI) homeowners improve indoor air quality and energy efficiency. |
| Appalachian Community Action & Development Agency | Gate City, VA | Operating a weatherization program that helps LMI homeowners reduce utility and health expenses by improving the living conditions and energy efficiency of their homes. |
| Boys, Girls, Adults Community Development Center | Marvell, AR | Inspecting homes, drafting rehabilitation plans, helping residents receive free energy upgrades and completing minor repairs for LMI homeowners. |
| Cabrillo Economic Development Corporation | Ventura, CA | Supporting predevelopment activities for a new 49-unit supportive housing project for households that are homeless and high-cost health users. |
| CAP Services | Stevens Point, WI | Rehabilitating and selling three single family homes to LMI households and incorporating healthy housing training into housing counseling and educational sessions for housing lending clients. |
| Central Mississippi Housing & Development Corp | Canton, MS | Preserving a 64-unit multifamily building through a substantial rehabilitation and providing educational workshops on healthy housing best practices and trainings on smoke free apartment living. |
| Community Housing Improvement Systems & Planning Association | Salinas, CA | Supporting development of 40 affordable apartments, primarily serving farmworker families and families with disabilities, designed with all-electric appliances, space and water heating as well as solar panels. |
| Community Action Partnership of Northwest Montana | Kalispell, MT | Supporting predevelopment activities for 17 modular studio units that will provide affordable homes for people experiencing homelessness; the site will include a vegetable garden, green space, and supportive services. |
| Community Development Corporation of South Berkshire | Great Barrington, MA | Supporting the development of a 49-unit affordable housing complex with healthy housing design components that include community gardens, play areas and six acres of on-site greenspace. |
| Delta Housing Development Corporation | Indianola, MS | Operating an Older Adult Home Modification Grant Program that enables low-income elderly adults to age in place through low-cost, low-barrier, high-impact home improvements. |
| GROW South Dakota | Sisseton, SD | Completing 105 home improvement projects, which include weatherization and energy efficiency upgrades. Providing healthy housing information to homeowners and homebuyers. |

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| Hilltown Community Development Corporation | Chesterfield, MA | Operating a rural housing rehabilitation program serving LMI households, which identifies and remediates environmental risks such as failed septic systems and removal of asbestos, lead and mold. |
| Human Resource Development Council of District IX | Bozeman, MT | Rehabilitating an eight-unit affordable senior housing development for better accessibility, energy efficiency and indoor air quality in response to increasing wildfire smoke in the area. |
| Lakes Region Community Developers | Laconia, NH | Assessing and rehabilitating 80 rental units across 33 multi-family buildings including lead abatement, replacing carpet with low-VOC flooring, conducting energy audits, and improving efficiency. |
| Mercy Housing and Human Development | Gulfport, MS | Repairing homes damaged by Hurricanes Ida and Zeta. Providing outreach, education and counseling to vulnerable households and offering no- and low-cost home improvements. |
| Neighborhood Nonprofit Housing Corporation | Logan, UT | Repairing and rehabilitating 35 LMI owner-occupied homes to create healthier conditions through the Northern Utah Neighborhood Improvement Program. |
| OPAL Community Land Trust | Eastsound, WA | Renovating a 12-unit apartment building to address deferred maintenance needs, remove mold and asbestos, improve heating, cooling, plumbing, insulation, ventilation, and indoor air quality. |
| Self-Help Enterprises | Visalia, CA | Implementing a healthy housing program for 23 permanent supportive housing residents who've experienced chronic homelessness to help them improve mental and physical health and build tenancy skills to stay housed. |
| Self-Help Homes | Provo, UT | Building 20 energy and water efficient single-family homes, incorporating a local trail system into the design to create a walkable community. Including healthy home practices in homebuyer training. |
| Southside Outreach Group Inc | South Boston, VA | Developing a 32-unit affordable multi-family building that meets Gold Level Green Building Standards of EarthCraft and includes accessible units built to universal design standards. |
| Total Concept | Fowler, CO | Providing financing and construction management services to LMI households in need of rehabilitation on single-family homes to address health and safety issues and bring them up to code. |
| Tunica County Community Development Coalition | Tunica, MS | Developing twelve Mutual Self-Help single-family homes according to healthy housing principals, which will be kept dry, clean, safe, pest-free, contaminant-free, well maintained, and thermally controlled. |
