What You Will Do

As the Financial Coaching Coordinator, you will conduct one-on-one financial coaching sessions with clients, focusing on personal finance management, credit building, and budgeting strategies, facilitate initial client assessments, develop tailored action plans, lead financial education workshops and seminars that are accessible to a diverse audience, engage with local community organizations and partners to reach new clients, represent Prosperous Detroit at community events, maintain confidential client records, and prepare reports on client engagement, workshop attendance, and other key metrics.

What Your Work Environment Will Be

An 11-month position where you will typically serve 20 hours a week, generally between Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., with occasional evenings and weekends. An exact schedule will be determined upon selection. You will report in person at our office and will be required to travel locally for meetings and community events.
